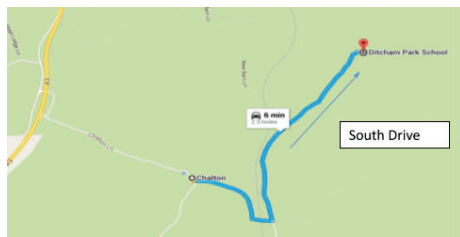
Time: Registration opens 8:00am and will close at 10:00am. It's advisable to be signed-on a minimum of 1hr prior to your scheduled start time

Additionally, the school is sign posted from Chalton Village.

Competitors Information

- Please note that the school have requested that **no dogs** are brought to the event
- Registration will be held in the Gym building, commencing at 8:00am and closing at 10:00am. It's advisable to be signed-on a minimum of 1hr before your scheduled start time
- Collect your race number and confirmed start time plus familiarise yourself with the directions to the start
- The sign-on team will have a list of BSCA members, both group and individual. All competitors that are not affiliated to the BSCA will need to buy a day license for £2 – cash only
- All bikes must be in full working order and must have brakes
- Girls will be started just after the boys in each age category
- Riders taking part must compete in the event by their own effort. We will not be permitting adults to run or ride alongside competitors during their child's race
- Medals will be awarded to the top three boys and girls in each age category.
- A separate 'Boys and Girls Team Prize' can be awarded in each age category. To be eligible for the Team Prize, there must be a minimum of 3 boys or 2 girls from the same school in the category. The overall team time is taken on the combined best three boys or best two girls from each school within each age category
- Allow a good 10 minutes to roll down to the start line. The U7's to U11's will be escorted by a Solent Pirates coach. U13's to O15's should allow 20mins to make their own way to the start line
- Please stay clear of riders on their Hill Climb when riding down to your start. At no time is anyone allowed to impede the progress of another rider
- The course will be well marshalled by coaches and volunteers from the Solent Pirates and Ditcham Park School
- Club Tents & Gazebos: We would really appreciate your support in helping us to achieve a more social area by centralising all the schools club tents and gazebos, outside of the Gym building, on the edge of the sports field



- Welfare: Changing facilities, toilets and refreshments will be available within the main Gym building
